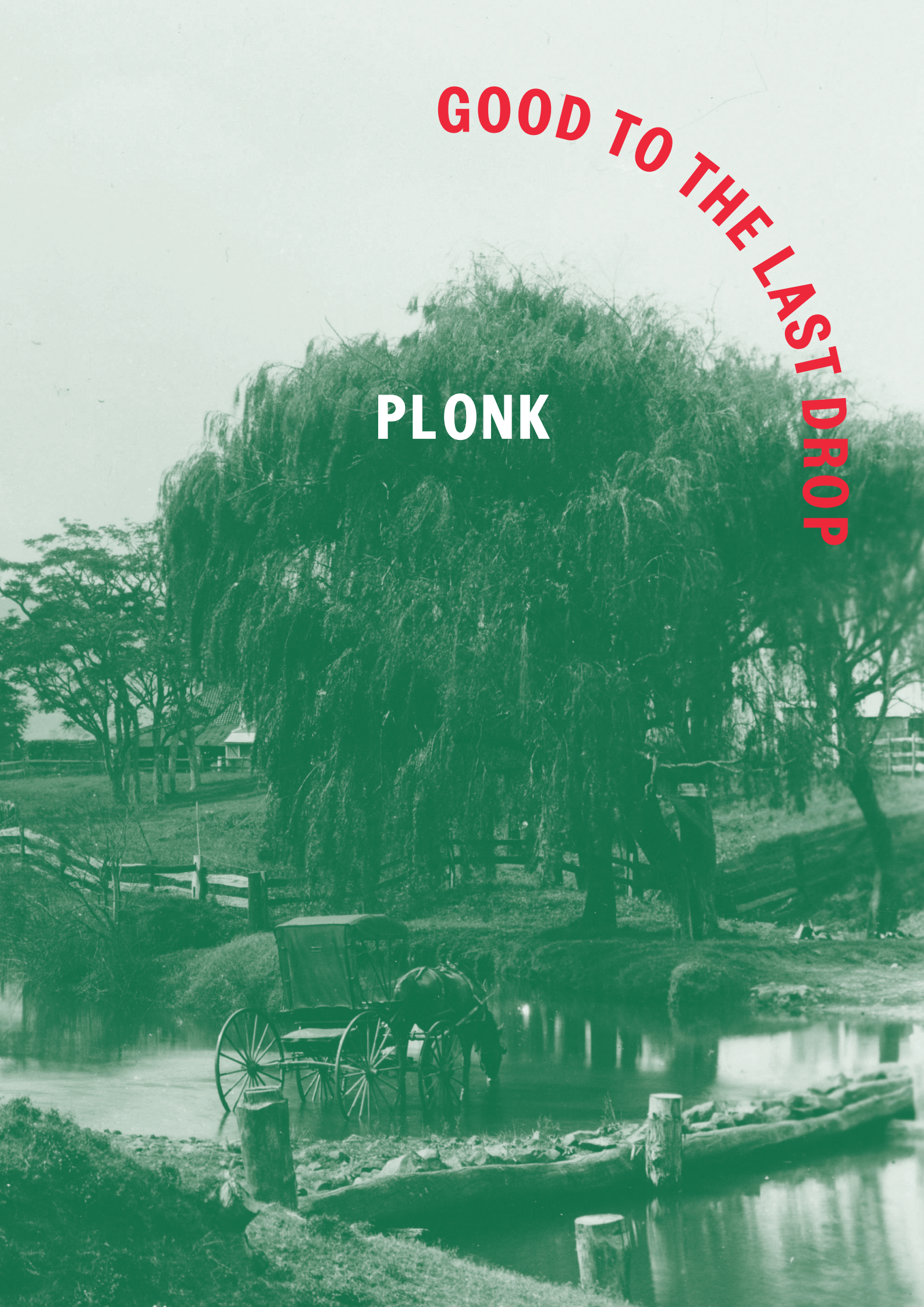

THERE IS NO RIGHT OR WRONG WAY TO DRINK WHISKY

HOW TO DRINK WHISKY

How each person drinks whisky is a personal choice. These are just a few suggestions to help you get the best out of your whisky.

WHISKY OR WHISKEY?

WHISKY - This is used by Scotland, Canada, Japan, Australia & pretty much everywhere else.

WHISKEY - our American friends & the Irish dare to be different. Its actually due to the different Gaelic the Irish used compared to the Scots then there were significant Irish immigrants to the USA so they use "E"

KEEP IT NEAT?

Whether or not you add water to your whisky is entirely about personal taste. Many who drink their whisky neat say they don't want to spoil the taste by adding water to it.

OR ADD WATER?

However, there are just as many whisky drinkers who say that adding a touch of water, especially soft still spring water, enhances the aroma & flavour & brings out hidden characteristics.

It's worth noting that tap water can contain high levels chlorine & would spoil rather than complement your whisky. If this is the case with your tap water, it is best avoided.

JUST A FIFTH?

Many lovers of whisky will drink with a little clear water. Adding a little water to whisky before drinking will prevent the strength of the whisky numbing your senses & reducing your enjoyment. It is widely said that you should dilute your whisky with a fifth of water.

UP TO YOU

Everyone's tastes vary. It's worth adding just a little water at a time to see what you prefer. At the end of the day, some whiskies are best without any water added. Once again, it's all up to you.

AMERICAN OR BOURBON WHISKEY

Biggest point of difference is that Bourbons require at least 51% corn of their grain makeup. Bourbon is matured in NEW charred oak barrels whilst whiskeys are matured in OLD charred oak barrels. Some ABV% guidelines are also required to be called bourbon.

A common misconception is that Bourbons must come from Kentucky however this is not the case & can be made anywhere in the US, although 95% of Bourbons come out of Kentucky anyway.



SCOTTISH WHISKY

HIGHLANDS

DALWHINNIE 15-YEAR-OLD

From the highest of all distillers in Scotland, placed to take advantage of the cleanest spring water possible. A smoky, serious yet approachable whisky.

Rich, mellow & smooth, this single malt is characterised by honey sweetness & a delicate layer of sherry that lingers on the palate.

THERE IS NO RIGHT OR WRONG WAY TO DRINK RUM

HOW TO DRINK RUM

It's a personal choice. These are a few pointers to help you along your journey with rum.

Please remember there's a rum for everyone!

THE LOOK

The first thing to note when tasting a new rum is the look. Is it clear, cloudy, light, golden or dark? Tilt the glass & hold it to the light & look at the edge where the rum meets the cup. You may see what appears to be a green ring - the darker this ring, the older the rum is likely to be.

THE LEGS

Now straighten the glass up & watch the rum run down the glass. This is known in the wine industry as the 'legs'. The thicker the legs, the more viscous it is. Full bodied rums will have thinner legs.

THE NOSE

'Nosing' is when you sniff the rum to soak in the delicious aromas. Short quick sniffs are best to capture all the different aromas. It's best to sniff the bottle when first opened & in a tumbler, once the air has had time to reduce some vapours.

You only have about seven seconds before your nose stops noticing things so try & identify the qualities quickly. The 'top sniff' is when you get the original notes. Then swirl the rum & place your nose in the glass deeper to detect more subtle aromas.

THE SIP

The first taste is always a bit of a shock to the tongue. Take just a small sip to get the light burn out of the way so you can then focus on the flavours. Then, take a second, slower sip & let the rum float around your mouth & the vapours float into your nose to identify more aromas.

THE CHARACTER

As you sip, try to determine the sweetness, bitterness, spiciness & acidity. Pay attention to the consistency of the rum - is it smooth, light, syrupy? Does the flavour intensify or stay the same? Swallow the rum & consider the aftertaste. How quickly does it fade away? Do more flavours present themselves?

THE ADDITION

There are more ways to further taste rum & identify even more aromas & flavours. Two popular methods are with a small dash of cool water, or by pouring the rum on ice. These methods spread out & reduce the intensity of stronger flavours & aromas, allowing other characteristics to come through.
